(also recorded in Mark 10:46-52 & Luke 18:35-43)

Top 10 things to “C” in this story:

1. **C _____ - to the City**
Verse 29 “And as they were going out from *Jericho*”

2. **C _____ - of the 2 Companions**
Verse 30 “And behold, two *blind* men sitting by the road”
Mark 10:46 “a *blind beggar* named Bartimaeus, the son of Timaeus, was sitting by the road.”

3. **C _____ - of the Convinced**
Verse 30-31 “hearing that Jesus was passing by, *cried out*, saying, “Lord, have mercy on us, Son of David!”

4. **C _____ - Correction**
Verse 31 “And the multitude sternly told them to *be quiet*”

5. **C _____ - for Clarity**
Verse 32-33 “Jesus stopped and *called them*, and said, “What do you want me to do for you? They said to Him, “Lord, we want our eyes to be opened.”

6. **C _____ - his Cloak**
Mark 10:50 “And casting aside his cloak, he jumped up, and came to Jesus.”

7. **C _____ - of Christ**
Verse 34 “And moved with *compassion*”

8. **C _____ - that Cures**
Verse 34 “*Jesus touched* their eyes; and immediately they regained their sight

9. **C _____ - that Continues**
Verse 34 “immediately they *regained their sight and followed Him*.”

10. **C _____ - of the Crowd**

Luke 18:43 "and began following Him, glorifying God; and when all the people saw it, they gave *praise to God.*"
