Ephesians 2:1 And you were dead in your trespasses and sins.

Ephesians 2:3 Among them we too all formerly lived in the lusts of our flesh, indulging the desires of the flesh and of the mind, and were by nature children of wrath, even as the rest.

- Ed Jarrett: There is really no good way to soften “the wrath of God” to mean anything other than an angry response on God’s part to human disobedience.

- The OT alone mentions God’s wrath over 600 times both directly and indirectly.
Romans 1:18 For the wrath of God is revealed from heaven against all ungodliness and unrighteousness of men who suppress the truth in unrighteousness.

As we consider the role of sin in our world and in our lives, how must we react if we are truly going to be awakened?
