1. We _____ with others in their struggles.

1 Corinthians 13:7 [Love] endures all things.

Job 14:1-2 How frail is humanity! How short is life, how full of trouble! ²We blossom like a flower and then wither. Like a passing shadow, we quickly disappear.

God loves this way!

Hebrews 13:5-6 [God] has said, "I will never leave you nor forsake you." ⁶So we can confidently say, "The Lord is my helper; I will not fear; what can man do to me?"

2. We _____ for others when the load's too heavy to carry alone.

1 Corinthians 13:7 [Love] endures all things.

- "endure" comes from a compound Greek word that means to "remain under."
- Galatians 6:2 Bear one another's burdens, and thereby fulfill the law of Christ.

3. We _____ others when they can't defend themselves.

1 Corinthians 13:7-8 [Love] bears all things, believes all things, hopes all things, endures all things. 8 Love never fails...

- "Fails" comes from a Greek word that means falls down.
- Real love doesn't fall down.
- The word infers the one we love has fallen down, but we stand firm.

4. We _____ others when they fail.

1 Corinthians 13:7-8 [Love] bears all things, believes all things, hopes all things, endures all things. 8 Love never fails...

- Our love doesn't fail even when the one loved does fail.
- Galatians 6:1-2 Brethren, even if anyone is caught in any trespass, you who are spiritual, restore such a one in a spirit of gentleness; *each one* looking to yourself, so that you too will not be tempted. 2 Bear one another's burdens, and thereby fulfill the law of Christ.
